Material referred to as glass-ceramics is produced when glass is converted into an almost wholly crystalline substance by a process of controlled crystallization. These types of articles are produced when the manufacturer adds nucleating agents (e. g. , metal oxides such as titanium dioxide and zirconium oxide or metals such as copper powder) to the glass batch. After the product is shaped by ordinary glass-making methods, it is maintained at a temperature that allows the glassy body to crystallize around the nucleating agents (devitrification). Analysis of a sample by the U. S. Customs laboratory is necessary to enable U. S. Customs to determine whether a product consists of glass-ceramics. Although decorative glass articles are generally classifiable in subheading 7013. 99, decorative glass articles of glass-ceramics are classifiable in subheading 7013. 10, not subheading 7013. 99. (Similarly, drinking glasses of glass-ceramics and other table kitchen glassware of glass-ceramics are classifiable in subheading 7013. 10, not subheadings 7013. 28, 7013. 37 or 7013. 49.) Subheadings 7013. 22, 7013. 33, 7013. 41 and 7013. 91: Lead Crystal Glassware Lead crystal glassware classifiable in the HTSUS subheadings 7013. 22 (stemware drinking glasses), 7013. 33 (other drinking glasses), 7013. 41 (other table kitchen glassware) and 7013. 91 (decorative glassware) must contain at least 24 percent lead monoxide by weight.
